On April 27th, 1891, Miss Garrett, the Secretary of the Baltimore Committee, addressed the following letter to the Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University :

TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. DOBBIN,

*President of the Board of Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University :*

MY DEAR SIR:—The Committees of the Women's Medical School Fund of the Johns Hopkins University will pay into your treasury, on May 1st, the sum of one hundred and nine thousand dollars or more. I hereby offer to the Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, to be added to that Fund, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, payable on October 1st, 1892, provided that on or before February 1st, 1892, there shall be in the hands of the Trustees, and shall by them be set apart for the use of the Medical School, the remaining sum necessary to constitute an endowment for such school of five hundred thousand dollars, and provided also that the Trustees do now by resolution agree that they will in that case open the Medical School of the Johns Hopkins University in October, 1892, and will give public notice in February, 1892, of its intended opening.



And inasmuch as my interest in the Medical School of the Johns Hopkins University is due in great part to my interest in the medical education of women, it shall be understood that in case the University shall discontinue a medical school devoted to the education of both men and women, or if at any time it can be shown by proper legal proceedings that the women studying in the Medical School do not enjoy all its advantages on the same terms as men, or are not admitted on the same terms as men to all prizes, dignities, or honors that are awarded by competitive examination, or regarded as rewards of merit, then the said sum of one hundred thousand dollars shall revert to me, or such person or persons, institution or institutions, as I by testament or otherwise may hereafter appoint.

I regret that my intended departure for Europe early in May compels me to ask for an answer from the Trustees on or before April 30th.

At a special meeting of the Board of Trustees, held on April 30th, 1891, the letter of Miss Mary E. Garrett, addressed to Hon. George W. Dobbin, President of the Board of Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, having been read and considered, the following minute was read and adopted :

The University will have in money and property applicable to its Medical School Fund, when it has received the \$109,000 in May, 1891, the sum of \$178,780.42.

The members of this Board will endeavor, individually, by enlisting the good offices of those interested in higher medical education, to obtain, before February 1st, 1892, additional contributions to be specially applied to such Medical School Fund, and to no other purposes, to the amount of \$221,219.58.



It will then, if successful before the date last referred to in raising this sum of \$221,219.58, be entitled to receive from Miss Mary E. Garrett, on October 1st, 1892, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars.

The sum necessary for the foundation of the Medical School of the University will then be assured.

If the Trustees succeed in obtaining, before February 1st, 1892, the additional contributions already referred to, amounting to \$221,219.58, they will give notice in February, 1892, that the Medical School of the University will be opened in October, 1892.

This Board accepts the conditions which Miss Mary E. Garrett has annexed to her proposed grant, payable on October 1st, 1892, and assures her of its grateful sense of the broad and liberal spirit in which she has assisted in the establishment of the Medical School of the University.

The President of the Board of Trustees is requested to transmit to Miss Garrett a copy of this minute, attested by his signature and by the seal of the University.

On May 1st, 1891, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, offered to the Trustees, and accepted by them on October 28th, 1890, together with the subscriptions subsequently received by the Committees, was handed over to the University, accompanied by the following letter :

TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. DOBBIN,

*President of the Board of Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University :*

MY DEAR SIR :—I enclose on behalf of the members of the committees of the Women's Fund for the Medical School of the Johns Hopkins University and of the subscribers, whose names are appended to this letter, a cheque for the amount of one hundred and eleven thousand and three hundred dollars ; one hundred thousand dollars being the sum already offered to the Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, provided that they should by resolution agree that women whose previous



training has been equivalent to that of the preliminary medical course of the University be admitted to the school, whenever it shall open, on the same terms as men, and accepted by them in their resolution of October 28th, 1890;\* and the remainder being the sum placed in the hands of the committees since October 28th, 1890, to be added to the Women's Fund for the Medical School of the Johns Hopkins University.

*RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON OCTOBER 28th, 1890.*

\* The President and Board of Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University have received from Mrs. Nancy Morris Davis, chairman of one of the committees formed for the purpose of raising a fund to procure the most advanced medical education for women, the gratifying intelligence that \$100,000.00 has been raised for the use of their intended Medical School, and is at their disposal, if they will, by resolution, agree to the terms upon which the money was contributed by its donors.

These terms are that this Board, if it accepts the funds thus raised, shall agree, by resolution, that, when its Medical School shall be opened, women whose previous training has been equivalent to the preliminary medical course prescribed for men, shall be admitted to such school upon the same terms as may be prescribed for men.

The offer to this University of the particular fund is the free voluntary act of women residing in this State and in other States, made without the suggestion or solicitation of this Board, and we accept it under and subject to the terms which are made a part of the gift, with the understanding and declaration, however, that such preliminary training in all its parts shall be obtained in some other institution of learning devoted, in whole or in part, to the education of women, or by private tuition.

The fund so contributed shall be invested and known as "The Women's Medical School Fund," and that fund, and all interest to accrue thereon, and all additions made thereto for the same purpose, shall remain invested for the purposes of increase only until, with its aid as a foundation, a general fund has been accumulated amounting to not less than \$500,000, and sufficient for the establishment and maintenance of a Medical School, worthy of the reputation of this University and fully sufficient as a means of complete medical instruction. Then, and not until then, will a Medical School be opened by this University; and then, and not until then, will the gift now offered be used by this University; and then, and not until then, will the terms attached thereto be operative.

The utility of a training school for women nurses has been demonstrated by the experience and practice of the Johns Hopkins Hospital, and by the necessities of home life among our people.

This Board is satisfied that in hospital practice among women, in penal institutions in which women are prisoners, in charitable institutions in which women are cared for, and in private life, when women are to be attended, there is a need and place for learned and capable women physicians; and that it is the business and duty of this Board, when it is supplied with the necessary means for opening its proposed Medical School, to make provision for the training and full qualification of such women for the abundant work which awaits them in these wide fields of usefulness.

Nothing contained in this minute shall be construed as abridging, in any manner, the right of the Board of Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University to make such rules and regulations as they may deem necessary for the government of its School of Medicine, when it is organized; and in making such rules and regulations, the terms of this minute shall always be respected and observed.

Which minute and resolution, being seconded, was thereupon unanimously adopted.

It should be noted that of this sum \$2,300 were received after the passing by the Trustees of their resolution of April 30th, and that the sum required to complete the endowment of the Medical School, provided it be completed before February 1st, 1892, is accordingly \$218,919.58.

The sum necessary to complete the endowment after that date would be \$318,919.58, and it is earnestly hoped that all those interested in higher medical education will unite to secure for the University the benefit of this conditional offer of \$100,000, and to bring about the opening, in October, 1892, of this great school.

On April 27th, 1891, Miss Garrett, the Secretary of the Baltimore Committee, addressed the following letter to the Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University :

TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. DOBBIN,

*President of the Board of Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University :*

MY DEAR SIR:—The Committees of the Women's Medical School Fund of the Johns Hopkins University will pay into your treasury, on May 1st, the sum of one hundred and nine thousand dollars or more. I hereby offer to the Trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, to be added to that Fund, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, payable on October 1st, 1892, provided that on or before February 1st, 1892, there shall be in the hands of the Trustees, and shall by them be set apart for the use of the Medical School, the remaining sum necessary to constitute an endowment for such school of five hundred thousand dollars, and provided also that the Trustees do now by resolution agree that they will in that case open the Medical School of the Johns Hopkins University in October, 1892, and will give public notice in February, 1892, of its intended opening.
