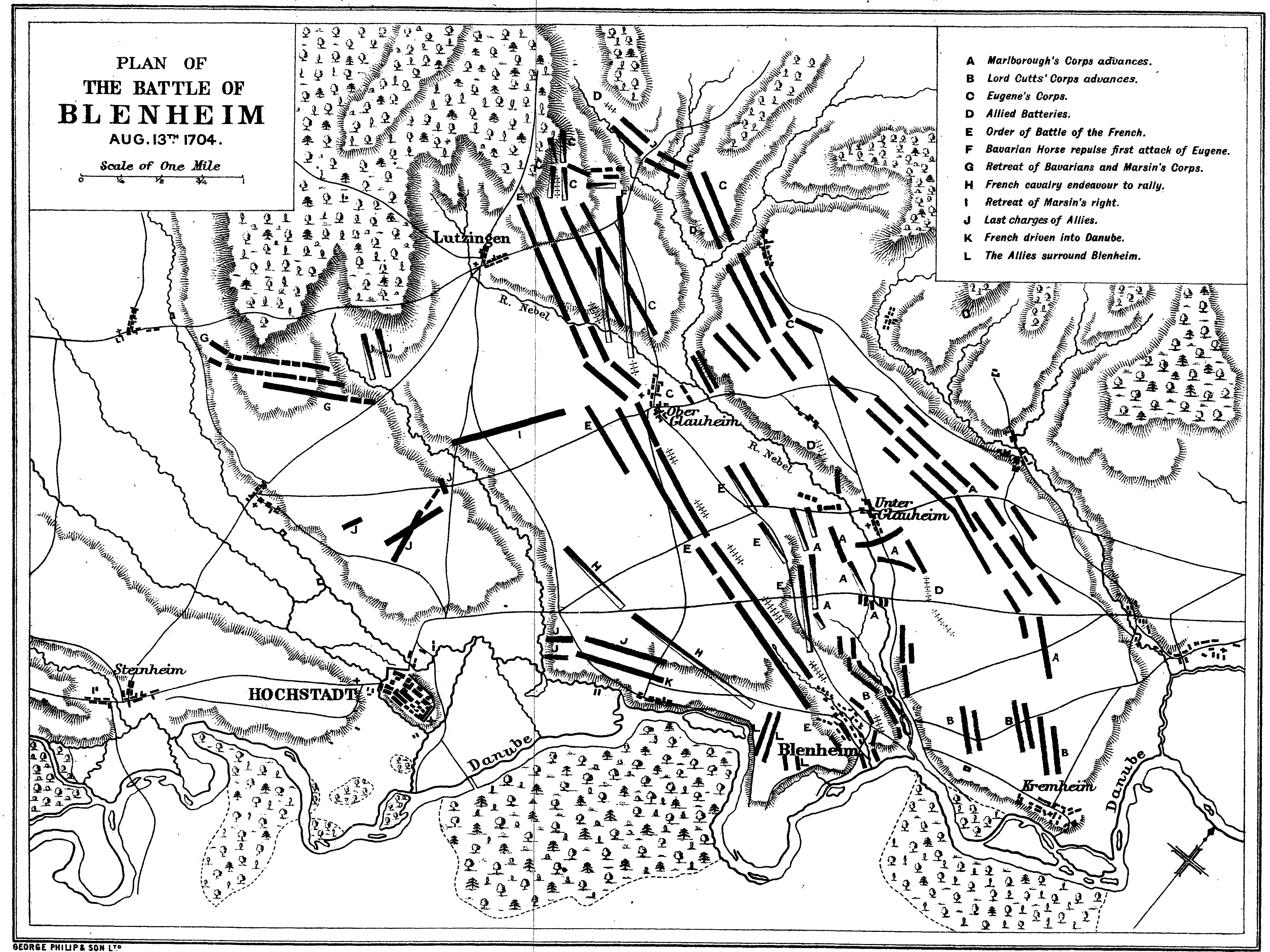
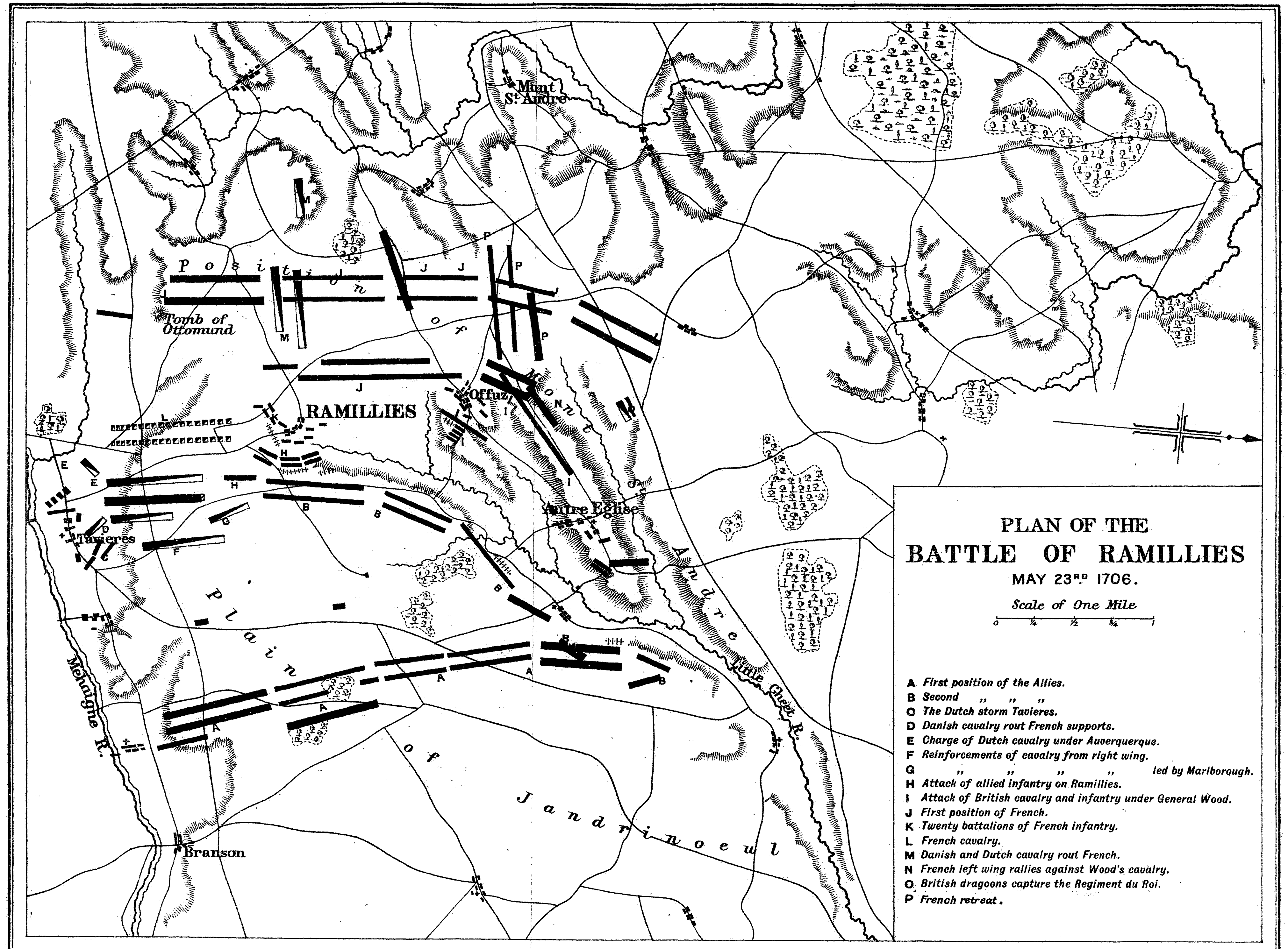




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PLAN OF THE

MAY 23RD 1706.

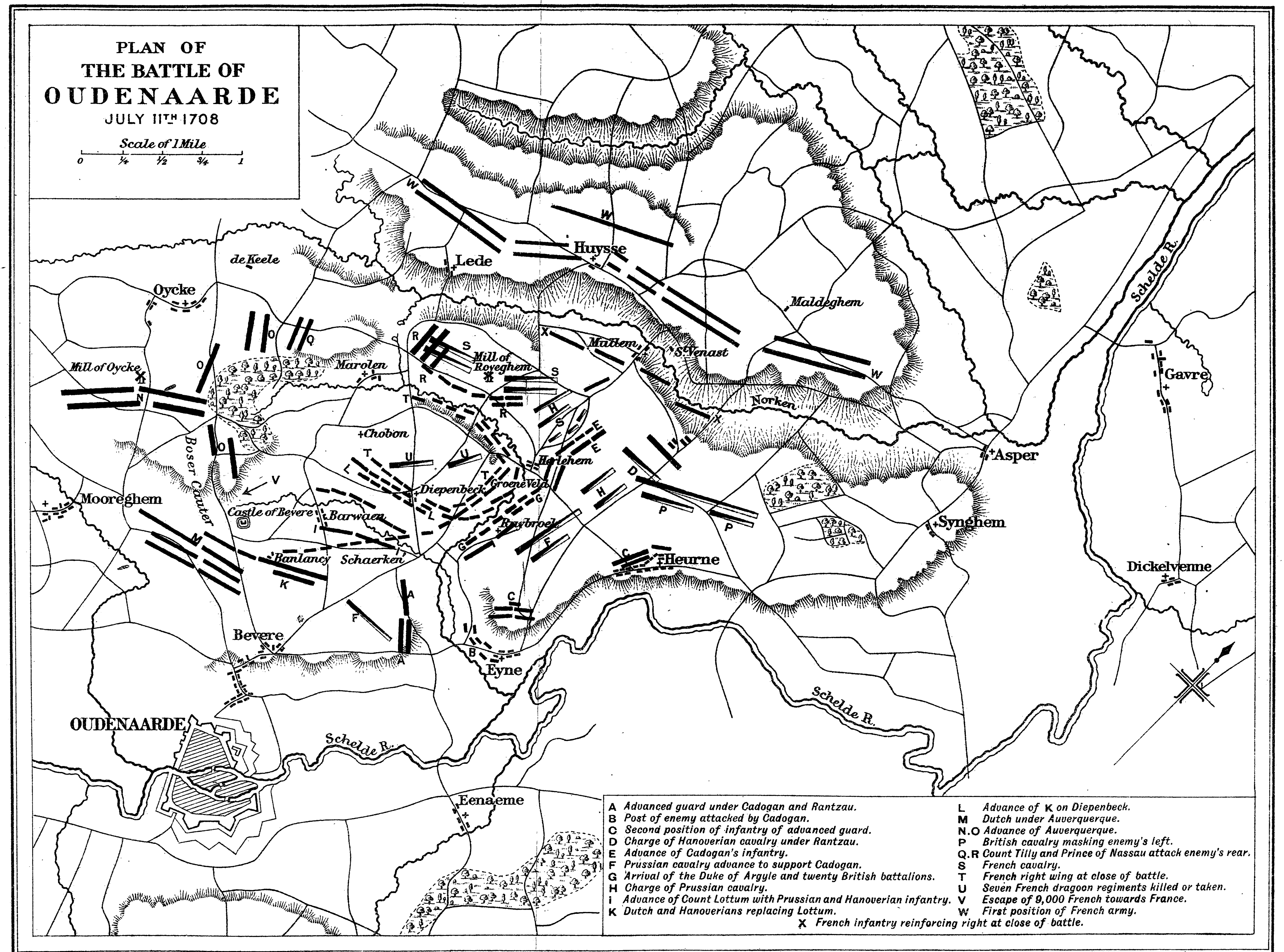

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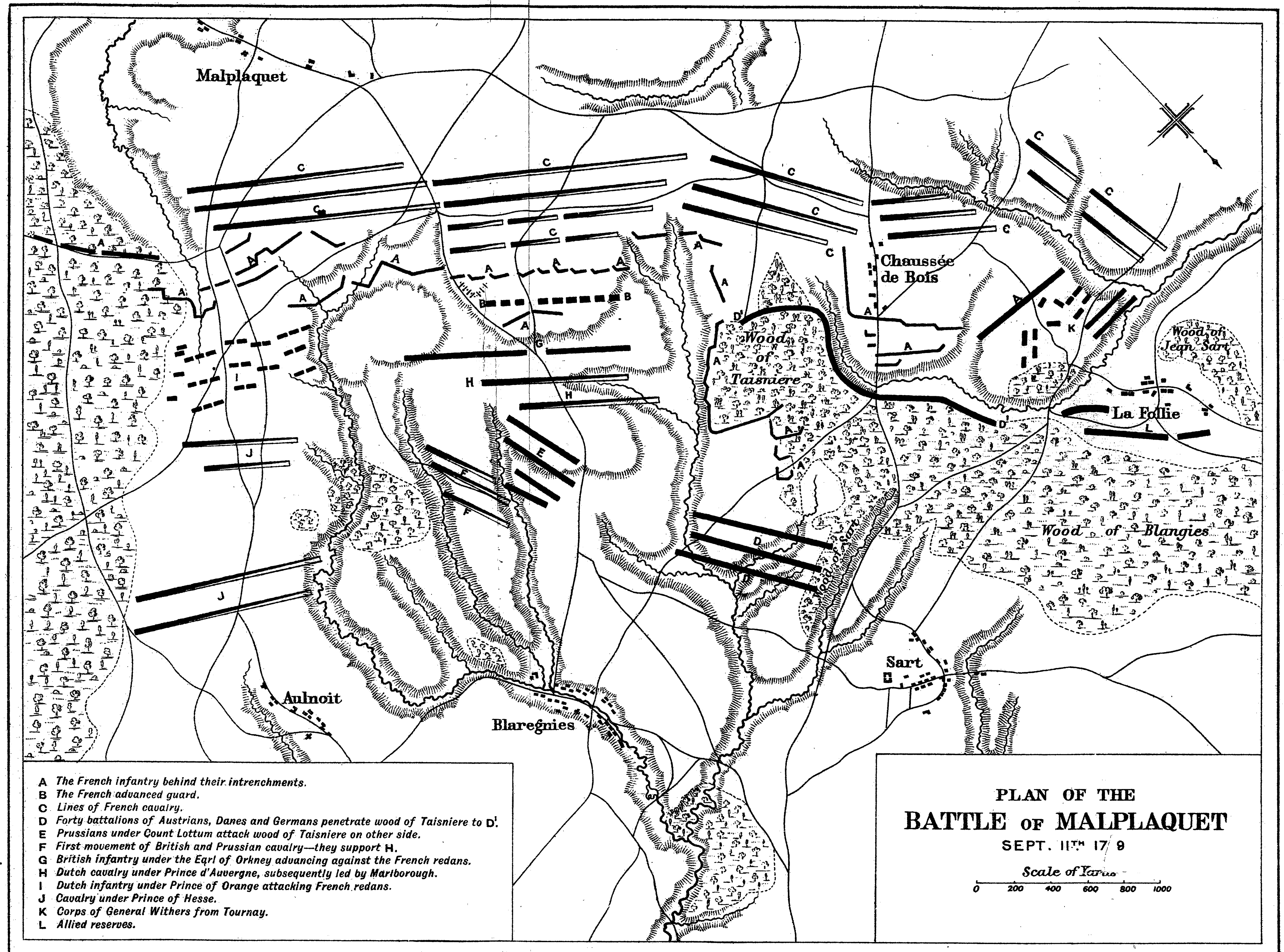
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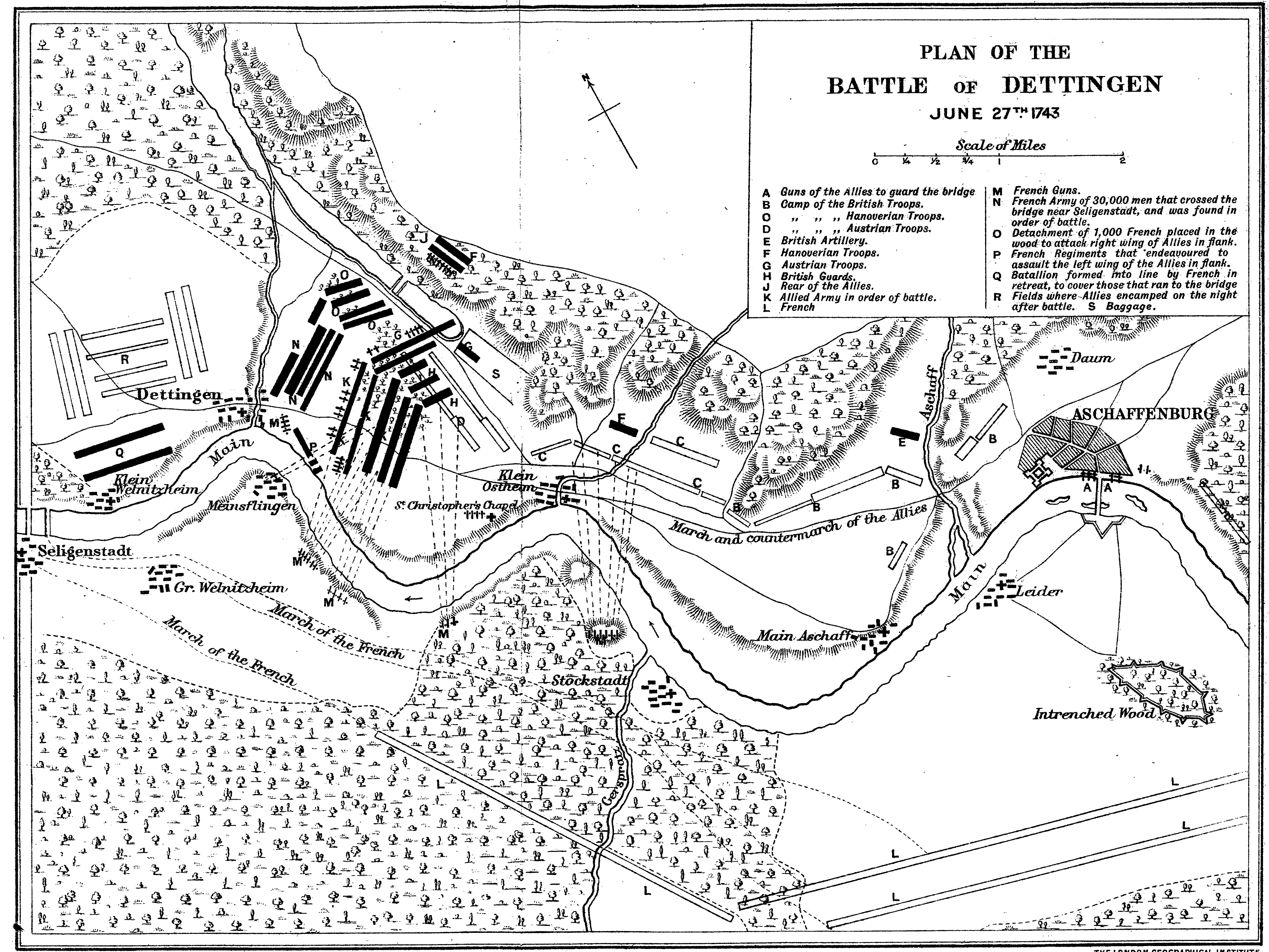
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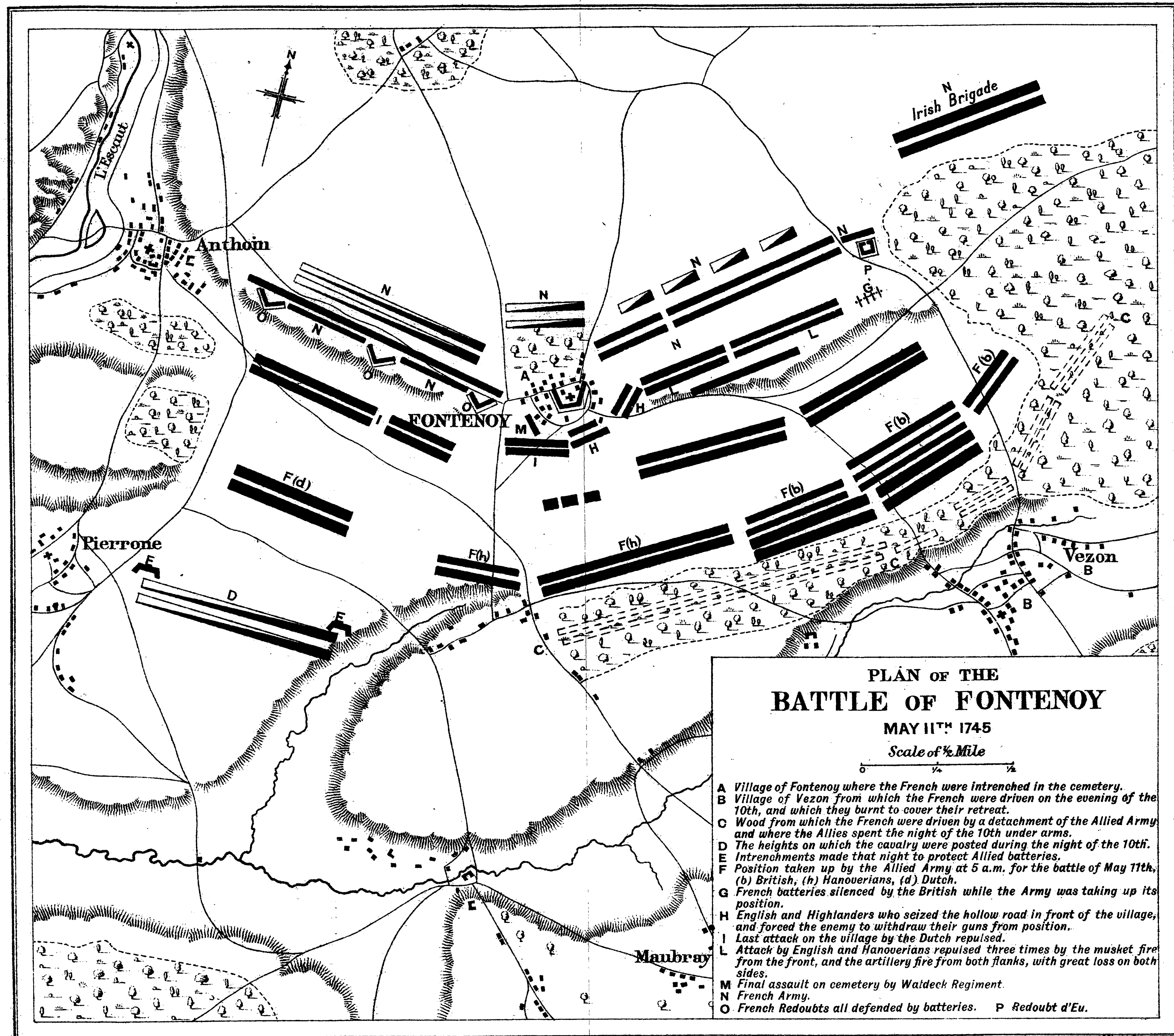
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PLAN OF THE BATTLE OF DETTINGEN JUNE 27th 1743

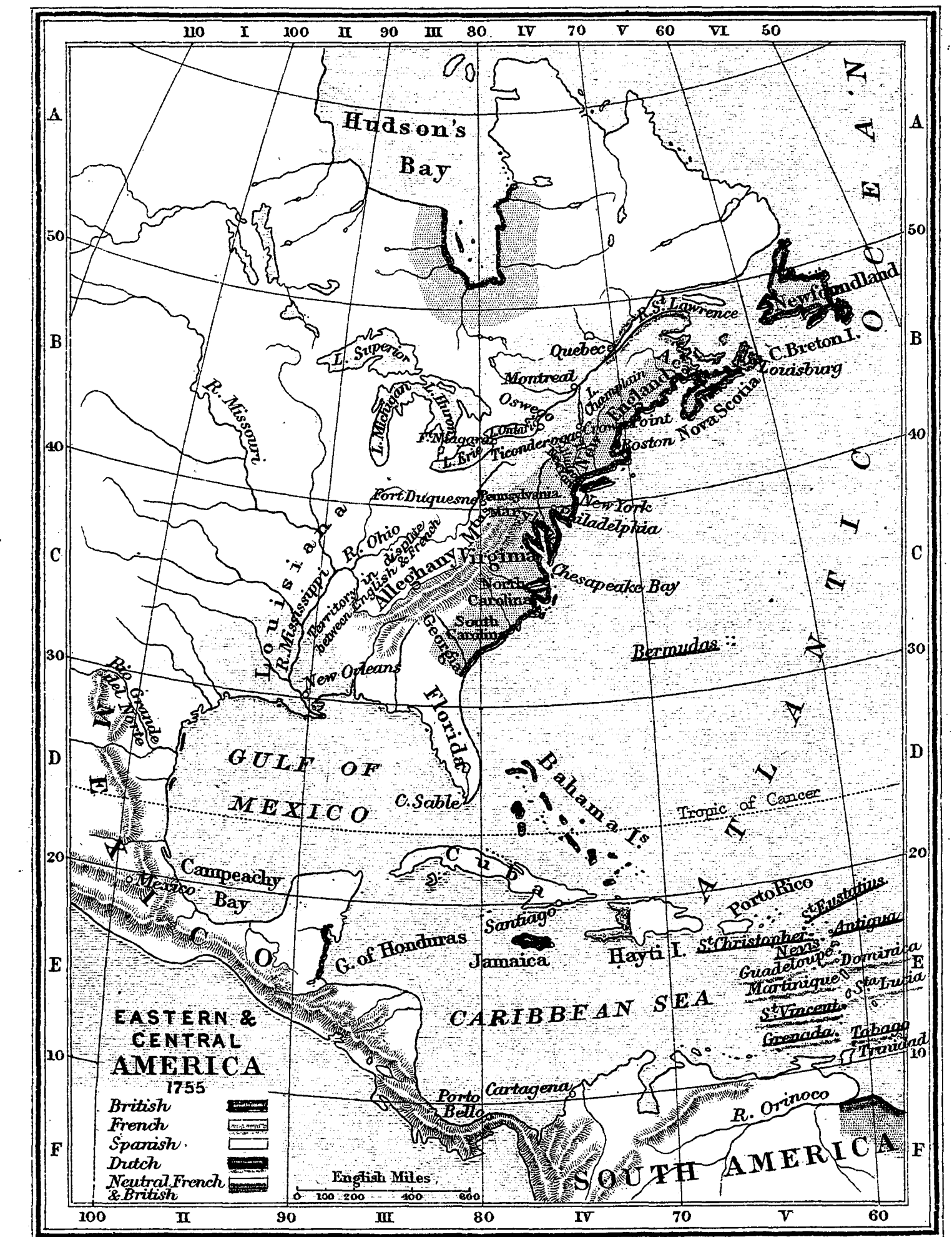

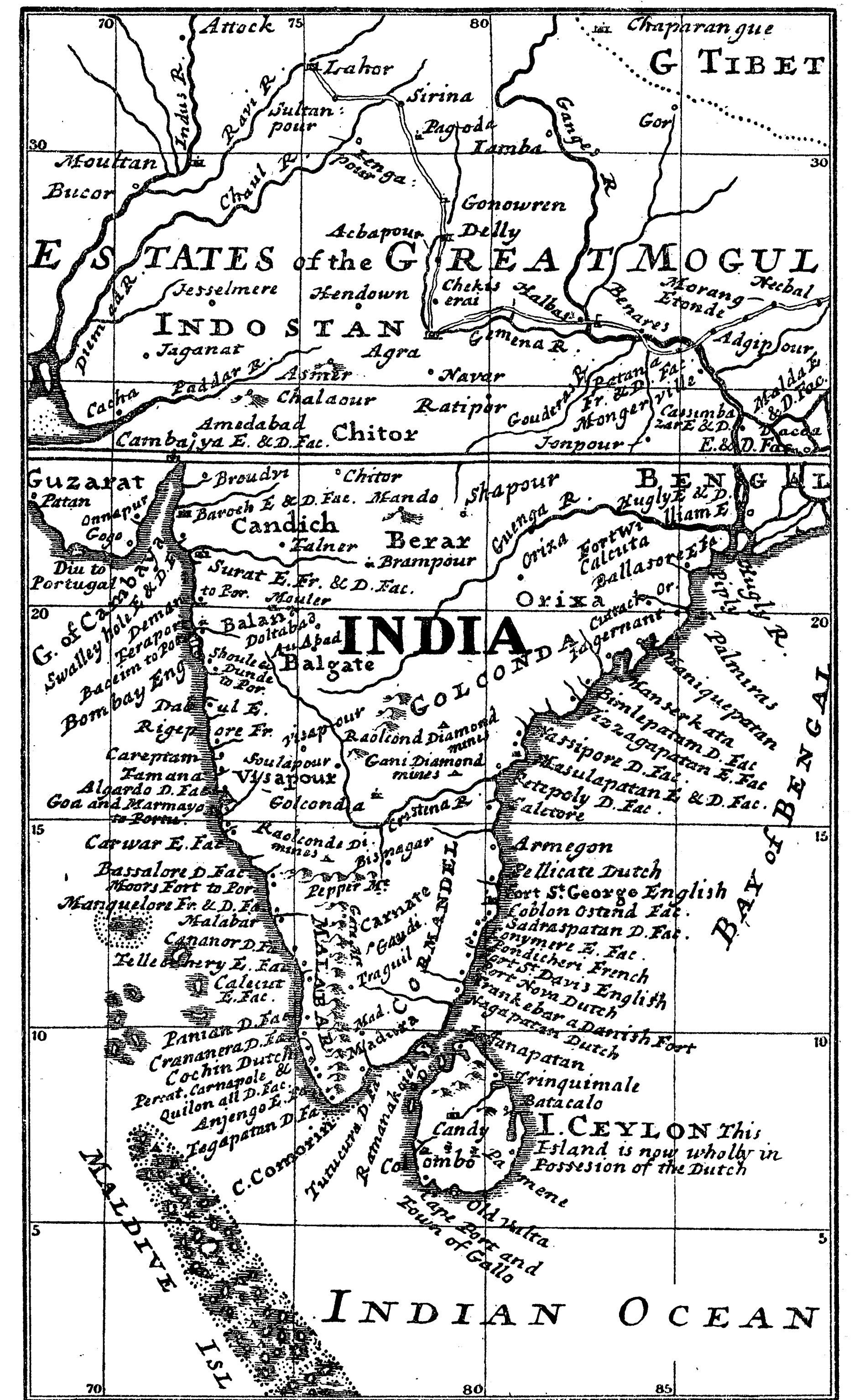
